November Board Meeting

The November board meeting was held on Friday, November 4, 2022.

Our current membership is 186 (158 Active, 28 Senior).

For the year ending and fiscal year through October 31, 2022, Treasurer **John Collar** reported operating income of \$4,588.49, operating expenses of \$3,290.04, service income of \$22,935.11, service expenses of \$3,439.23, and net assets of \$20,794.33.

Discussion was held regarding the anticipated Kiwanis International dues increase for the next fiscal year and corporate membership. Partners Read program is on hold until there are spots available. The Pancake Breakfast Service Budget Fundraiser is estimated to have brought in around \$25,000 with 70% of the club members participating in ticket purchases. Volunteer opportunities coming up in November and December were presented. Kevin Benedict will especially need help on December 15 for the Boys and Girls Christmas Party. The meeting was adjourned and the board held a retreat. The next board meeting is scheduled for December 8.
