Board Meeting May 12, 2022



The May board meeting was held via Zoom on Thursday, May 12, 2022. The senior membership request of **Marshall Mauney** (former member) was approved unanimously. The resignation of **Jim Blaine** was accepted with regret.

Our current membership is 193 (162 active and 31 senior).

For the fiscal year ending April 30, 2022, Treasurer **John Collar** reported operating income of \$49,206.26, operating expenses of \$59,134.09, service income of \$21,600, service expenses of \$2,861.27, net assets of \$100,231.39, and accounts receivable of \$14,552.

Registrations are coming in for Charter Night. The Past President's Lunch will be held in September. Rick McElroy, chair of the Pancake Committee held his first meeting on May 11.

A new nomination for Buck Lattimore's seat in October needs to be filled.

A discussion was held regarding partnering with the Raleigh Jaycees on some service projects and offering mentoring opportunities between members of both groups. The need for more service projects was discussed. Short-term and long-term ideas are needed.
