Board Meeting April 14, 2022



The April meeting was held via Zoom on Thursday, April 14, 2022. The membership approval of **Mack Jenkins, Mary Wells, Grady Jackson, and Lesley Lombard** were approved unanimously. The resignations of **Jerry Monday, Sharron Parro, Kara Brunk, and JC Knowles** were accepted with regret.

Our current membership is 193 (163 active and 30 senior).

For the fiscal year through March 31, 2022, Treasurer **John Collar** reported operating income of \$37,947.13, operating expenses of \$53,710.18, service income of \$21,600, service expenses of \$2,861.27, net assets of \$94,396.17, and accounts receivable of \$7,155.00.

Corporate Membership was discussed as there is interest in that designation for membership. It was approved that we would present an increased, one-time fee for Corporate Members of \$300 with quarterly dues the same as Active Members. The board approved sending **Chris White** as our club delegate to the Kiwanis International Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana on June 8 - 11. We are waiting for Key Club scholarships to come in.
