#### **March Board Meeting**

The March board meeting was held on Tuesday, March 19, 2024. Our current membership remains at 173 (145 Active, 28 Senior). For the fiscal year through February 29, 2024, Treasurer John Collar reported operating income of \$36,525.05, operating expenses of \$68,303.23, service income of \$26,710.28, service expenses of \$4,745.07, and net assets of \$55,089.20.

Resignations from Tarver Sammons (health) and Tommy Manning were accepted with regret. An update was given on the Diaper Drive for the Diaper Train. The nominations committee announced the slate of officers and directors that will be presented mid April. The Golf Tournament is gearing up and the flyer is being updated. The Spring Social at the Durham Bulls game will be held on **Wednesday**, **June 26**. There will be no meeting on Friday, June 28. It was asked that we restart the Hospitality outreach that was done during COVID to touch base with members we haven't seen in a while. The next board meeting will be on April 9, 2024 at John Collar's office.


