Board Meeting September 17, 2020



The September board meeting was held by video conference.

A resignation from **Tama Coleman** was accepted with regrets, and the death of **Tom Cowherd** was noted with sadness. Our current membership is 213 (185 active and 28 senior).

For the fiscal year through August 31, Treasurer **Larry Hamilton** reported operating income of \$71,457.17, operating expenses of \$59,371.26, service income of \$23,086.86, service expenses of \$16,782.21, net cash assets of \$92,670.31, and accounts receivable of \$6,308.00.
