## Board Meeting October 8, 2020



The October board meeting was held by video conference. President-Elect **Sandra Birkhead**, Treasurer **John Collar**, and directors **Randy Hartley** and **Stuart Phoenix** were welcomed to the board.

There were no new members. Resignations from **Jeff Ellington**, **Marshall Mauney**, **Jack Radford**, **Alex Pully**, and **Kristine Wager** were accepted with regrets, and **John Brantley's** change to senior status is effective this month. Our current membership is 208 (180 active and 28 senior).

For the fiscal year ending September 30, Treasurer **John Collar** reported operating income of \$73,871.22, operating expenses of \$60,591.22, service income of \$33,772.26, service expenses of \$28,772.26, net cash assets of \$92,559.75, and accounts receivable of \$4,429.50.

The board approved an operating budget of \$76,350.00 and a service budget of \$35,000.00 for the 2020-2021 fiscal year (October 1, 2020, to September 30, 2021). There is a projected deficit of \$6,000.00 for the operating budget and \$5,000.00 for the service budget.

The board heard reports from the Raleigh Kiwanis Golf Classic and Pancake Breakfast Committees. An in-person meeting on November 6 was approved, and other in-person meetings through November 30 were canceled.

## Raleigh Kiwanis Foundation Annual Meeting

Foundation President **Patrick Yanke** conducted the Raleigh Kiwanis Foundation annual meeting on October 2, 2020.

The membership of the Raleigh Kiwanis Foundation consists of all members in good standing of the Kiwanis Club of Raleigh. The Foundation began functioning in 1947 and was incorporated in 1954. Since 1955, grants totaling over \$1,300,000 have been distributed to at least 90 different organizations.

Foundation assets were \$865,408.54 on September 30. 28 grants totaling \$17,690 were distributed to local agencies in January, plus a \$25,000 allotment to the City of Raleigh Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Department for our 2020 Centennial Parks Project. About 30 agencies have submitted applications for the grants to be awarded early next year.

The officers and directors were thanked for their service throughout the year. **Helen Ballentine**, **Buck Lattimore**, and **Patrick Yanke** are coming off the board at the end of 2020. **Brian Bennett** was thanked for his continuing service as treasurer, and **Paul Reynolds** of Triangle Securities was thanked for managing our investment account.

**Cricket Harrell**, **George Ramsay**, and **June Small** were elected to serve three-year terms as directors beginning January 2021.

*CHANGE THE FUTURE* is a Club fundraising project that generates funds for the Foundation through birthday checks and spare change. Thanks to everyone who has contributed, to **Jimmy King** for chairing this year, and to **Chris White** for starting the project during his year as Club president. Through September, the campaign has raised \$26,575.91.

Members are asked to continue giving to *CHANGE THE FUTURE*, to consider a year end gift to the Foundation, and to remember the Foundation when identifying bequests in their wills. A donation of any amount will help to grow our Foundation.
